

## Clearswift Licensing Guidelines 2016

These guidelines are supplementary to the Clearswift End User License Agreement. Clearswift offers either perpetual or subscription licenses by users, instances, size, bundles or as otherwise specified on a per Product basis as per the table below. Any License is granted subject to the limits specified per unit as stated in any applicable License Record, "License Allowance"; a Licensee can only exceed those limits with express permission from Clearswift and/ or by paying additional fees to increase the License Allowance.

### Definitions:

**User:** *means each uniquely identified individual, whether an employee, temporary employee, contractor, or guest of the End User who benefits from our Product(s) directly or indirectly, for the avoidance of doubt it excludes an automated system, but it does include unique email addresses;*

**Application User:** *means an automated mail processing system;*

**Instance:** *means a single physical or virtual server used to process data as part of a Clearswift product set;*

**Primary configuration server:** *means, for the purposes of the Clearswift SMTP Product only, the policy management element of the Clearswift Product(s). The central location for all email policies that are to be applied to the Policy Servers;*

**Policy Server:** *means the enforcement point as configured by a primary configuration server;*

**CPU Core:** *means a virtual or physical CPU Core (e.g a Dual Core CPU will count as 2 cores);*

**Bundle:** *means a combination of units that apply to the License Record, which may include access to additional features of the Clearswift Product(s);*

**Connectors:** *means the number of interconnected Clearswift products or other compatible products;*

**Terabyte:** *means the amount of data that a Product will be licensed to process in a given time period.*
